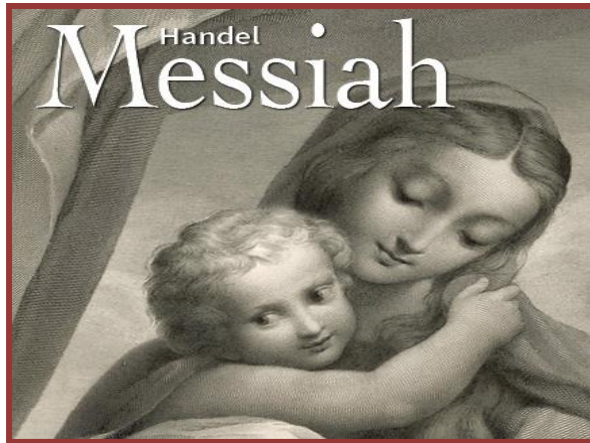
Pew Sheet deadline: The deadline for the July and August edition (one Pew sheet due to holidays) is 18 June.
